

CHI Port Angeles Guest Policy

- 1. **Duration of Stay**: Guests are permitted to stay overnight for a maximum of 3 consecutive nights within a certain time frame designated by the discretion of the manager. Extended stays beyond this period require prior approval from dormitory management.
- 2. **Quiet Hours**: Guests must adhere to the dormitory's quiet hours policy and respect the rights of other residents to a peaceful living environment. Excessive noise or disruptive behavior by guests will not be tolerated.
- 3. **Accompaniment**: Residents are responsible for accompanying their guests at all times while within the dormitory premises. Guests should not be left unattended in common areas or dorm rooms.
- 4. **Liability**: Residents are liable for the actions and behavior of their guests at all times. Any damages to dormitory property or violations of dormitory rules by guests will be the responsibility of the hosting resident.
- 5. **Security Measures**: Guests must comply with all security measures in place within the dormitory, including notifying CHI management for overnight stays, presenting valid identification upon request, and following any instructions from dormitory staff.
- 6. **Right to Deny Access**: Dormitory management reserves the right to deny access or trespass any guest who violates the guest policy or poses a risk to the safety or well-being of residents or for any reasonable reason.
- 7. **Behavioral Expectations**: Residents are responsible for ensuring that their guests adhere to the same behavioral standards and expectations as residents. This includes respecting quiet hours, maintaining cleanliness, and treating fellow residents and staff with courtesy and respect.
- 8. **Compliance with Policies**: Residents hosting guests are responsible for familiarizing their guests with dormitory policies, rules, and regulations, and ensuring their compliance throughout their visit. This includes providing guests with information on quiet hours, guest amenities, and emergency procedures.
- 9. Guest Check-In Procedure for Overnight Stays: Residents of CHI are required to check in or notify any overnight guests staying in their dormitory room with CHI management. Providing the guest's details, and obtaining approval from dormitory management. Residents must also seek consent from their pod mates before hosting an overnight guest and address any concerns raised. Upon arrival the guest must adhere to all dormitory rules. Non-compliance may result in disciplinary action and removal of the guest.
